The Bible (ESV unless noted)

Matthew 3:17 This (NIV)

This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.

Matthew 3:17 chosen (MSG)

...chosen and marked by my love, delight of my life.

Luke 1:28 Rejoice (NKJV)

Rejoice, highly favored *one*, the Lord *is* with you; blessed *are* you among women!

Luke 1:28 You're (to out) (MSG)

You're beautiful with God's beauty, Beautiful inside and out!

Psalms 139:1,

O LORD, you have searched me and known me! I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

Galatians 4:7 (MSG)

Doesn't that privilege of intimate conversation with God make it plain that you are not a slave, but a child? And if you are a child, you're also an heir, with complete access to the inheritance.

Romans 12:2 (MSG)

Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

...GOD himself took charge of his people, took Jacob on as his personal concern.

He threw his arms around him, lavished attention on him, guarding him as the apple of his eye.

Psalm 8:1, 3-6

Matthew 5:14-15 (MSG)

You’re here to be light, bringing out the God-colors in the world. God is not a secret to be kept. We’re going public with this, as public as a city on a hill. If I make you light-bearers, you don’t think I’m going to hide you under a bucket, do you? I’m putting you on a light stand. Now that I’ve put you there on a hilltop, on a light stand—shine!

Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, in Aramaic called Bethesda, which has five roofed colonnades. One man was there who had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. Ephesians 5:8-14 (MSG)

516:21

Man and woman as coexistent and eternal with God forever reflect, in glorified quality, the infinite Father-Mother God.

No 17:7-12 (to ;), 13-14 God

“In Him we live, and move, and have our being;” consequently it is impossible for the true man — who is a spiritual and individual being, created in the eternal Science of being — to be conscious of aught but good. God’s image and likeness can never be less than a good man;

God is not without an ever-present witness, testifying of Himself.

Mis. 14:2-5 (to facts)

Divest your thought, then, of the mortal and material view which contradicts the ever-presence and all-power of good; take in only the immortal facts...

Mis. 99:1-5

Science is absolute and final. It is revolutionary in its very nature; for it upsets all that is not upright. It annuls false evidence, and saith to the five material senses, “Having eyes ye see not, and ears ye hear not; neither can you understand.”

Un. 8:6-12

What you see, hear, feel, is a mode of consciousness, and can have no other reality than the sense you entertain of it.

It is dangerous to rest upon the evidence of the senses, for this evidence is not absolute, and therefore not real, in our sense of the word.

259:6

The divine nature was best expressed in Christ Jesus, who threw upon mortals the truer reflection of God and lifted their lives higher than their poor thought-models would allow,—thoughts which presented man as fallen, sick, sinning, and dying.

91:16

Absorbed in material selfhood we discern and reflect but faintly the substance of Life or Mind. The denial of material selfhood aids the discernment of man's spiritual and eternal individuality, and destroys the erroneous knowledge gained from matter or through what are termed the material senses.

68:6

We ought to weary of the fleeting and false and to cherish nothing which hinders our highest selfhood.

294:25

Man's genuine selfhood is recognizable only in what is good and true. Man is neither self-made nor made by mortals. God created man.

Mis. 183:24-31

Asserting a selfhood apart from God, is a denial of man's spiritual sonship; for it claims another father. As many as do receive a knowledge of God through Science, will have power to reflect His power, in proof of man's "dominion over all the earth." He is bravely brave who dares at this date refute the evidence of material sense with the facts of Science, and will arrive at the true status of man because of it.

481:2-3, 5

Man is tributary to God, Spirit, and to nothing else. Like the archpriests of yore, man is free "to enter into the holiest," — the realm of God.

471:13-18

The facts of divine Science should be admitted, — although the evidence as to these facts is not supported by evil, by matter, or by material sense, — because the evidence that God and man coexist is fully sustained by spiritual sense. Man is, and forever has been, God's reflection.

Mis. 185:7-14

Self-renunciation of all that constitutes a so-called material man, and the acknowledgment and achievement of his spiritual identity as the child of God, is Science that opens the very flood-gates of heaven; whence good flows into every avenue of being, cleansing mortals of all uncleanness, destroying all suffering, and demonstrating the true image and likeness.

476:21-22

Learn this, O mortal, and earnestly seek the spiritual status of man, which is outside of all material selfhood.

538:3 (only)

Truth should, and does, drive error out of all selfhood.

470:18

The standard of perfection was originally God and man. Has God taken down His own standard, and has man fallen?

My 165:16

As an active portion of one stupendous whole, goodness identifies man with universal good. Thus may each member of this church rise above the oft-repeated inquiry, What am I? to the scientific response: I am able to impart truth, health, and happiness, and this is my rock of salvation and my reason for existing.

My 191:9-10

Children of light, you are not children of darkness. Let your light shine.

265:1-3, 10

Man is the offspring, not of the lowest, but of the highest qualities of Mind.

This scientific sense of being, forsaking matter for Spirit, by no means suggests man's absorption into Deity and the loss of his identity, but confers upon man enlarged individuality, a wider sphere of thought and action, a more expansive love, a higher and more permanent peace.

Un. 6:4

Sooner or later the whole human race will learn that, in proportion as the spotless selfhood of God is understood, human nature will be renovated, and man will receive a higher selfhood, derived from God, and the redemption of mortals from sin, sickness, and death be established on everlasting foundations.

Un 46:7

I do not deny, I maintain, the individuality and reality of man; but I do so on a divine Principle, not based on a human conception and birth. The scientific man and his Maker are here; and you would be none other than this man, if

you would subordinate the fleshly perceptions to the spiritual sense and source of being.

249:1

Let us accept Science, relinquish all theories based on sense-testimony, give up imperfect models and illusive ideals; and so let us have one God, one Mind, and that one perfect, producing His own models of excellence.

519:3 Deity

Deity was satisfied with His work. How could He be otherwise, since the spiritual creation was the outgrowth, the emanation, of His infinite self-containment and immortal wisdom?

249:6-7 (to life), 5 only
