Do you have any idea how powerful God is? Take a long, hard look. See how great he is—infinite, greater than anything you could ever imagine or figure out!

God created the heavens and earth.

135:17

There is to-day danger of repeating the offence of the Jews by limiting the Holy One of Israel and asking: "Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?"  
What cannot God do?

265:5

Mortals must gravitate Godward, their affections and aims grow spiritual,-- they must near the broader interpretations of being, and gain some proper sense of the infinite,--in order that sin and mortality may be put off.

409:23

This mortal is put off, and the new man or real man is put on, in proportion as mortals realize the Science of man and seek the true model.

507:24-29

Infinite Mind creates and governs all, from the mental molecule to infinity. This divine Principle of all expresses Science and art throughout His creation, and the immortality of man and the universe. Creation is ever appearing, and must ever continue to appear from the nature of its inexhaustible source.

330:11-12

God is infinite, the only Life, substance, Spirit, or Soul, the only intelligence of the universe, including man.

353:28 only (to 1<sup>st</sup>.)

Mind is limitless.

466:13-14 2<sup>nd</sup> *Truth* (to 1<sup>st</sup> ;)

Truth is limitless;

278:11

Spirit can have no opposite.

157:30 only *Life*

Life is continuous and harmonious.

518:27-29

The divine Principle, or Spirit, comprehends and expresses all, and all must therefore be as perfect as the divine Principle is perfect.

340:12

Divine Love is infinite. Therefore all that really exists is in and of God, and manifests His love.

258:13-16

God expresses in man the infinite idea forever developing itself, broadening and rising higher and higher from a boundless basis. Mind manifests all that exists in the infinitude of Truth.

295:5-8

God creates and governs the universe, including man. The universe is filled with spiritual ideas, which He evolves, and they are obedient to the Mind that makes them.

381:17

In infinite Life and Love there is no sickness, sin, nor death, and the Scriptures declare that we live, move, and have our being in the infinite God.

223:7-9

God is infinite, omnipresent Spirit. If Spirit is all and is everywhere, what and where is matter?

300:2-5

Finite sense has no true appreciation of infinite Principle, God, or of His infinite image or reflection, man.

258:1

A mortal, corporeal, or finite conception of God cannot embrace the glories of limitless, incorporeal Life and Love. Hence the unsatisfied human craving for something better, higher, holier, than is afforded by a material belief in a physical God and man. The insufficiency of this belief to supply the true idea proves the falsity of material belief.

93:21-22, 28

The belief that Spirit is finite as well as infinite has darkened all history.

Finite spirit would be mortal, and this is the error embodied in the belief that the infinite can be contained in the finite. This belief tends to becloud our

apprehension of the kingdom of heaven and of the reign of harmony in the Science of being.

255:11-14

Mortal man has made a covenant with his eyes to belittle Deity with human conceptions. In league with material sense, mortals take limited views of all things.

62:29-1

Our false views of life hide eternal harmony, and produce the ills of which we complain. Because mortals believe in material laws and reject the Science of Mind, this does not make materiality first and the superior law of Soul last.

189:18

The human mortal mind, by an inevitable perversion, makes all things start from the lowest instead of from the highest mortal thought. The reverse is the case with all the formations of the immortal divine Mind. They proceed from the divine source; and so, in tracing them, we constantly ascend in infinite being.

495:15

Let neither fear nor doubt overshadow your clear sense and calm trust, that the recognition of life harmonious--as Life eternally is--can destroy any painful sense of, or belief in, that which Life is not. Let Christian Science, instead of corporeal sense, support your understanding of being, and this understanding will supplant error with Truth, replace mortality with immortality, and silence discord with harmony.

285:17

The time has come for a finite conception of the infinite and of a material body as the seat of Mind to give place to a diviner sense of intelligence and its manifestations,-- to the better understanding that Science gives of the Supreme Being, or divine Principle, and idea.

516:19

Man, made in His likeness, possesses and reflects God's dominion over all the earth. Man and woman as coexistent and eternal with God forever reflect, in glorified quality, the infinite Father-Mother God.

90:24-25

The admission to one's self that man is God's own likeness sets man free to master the infinite idea.

476:32-5

Jesus beheld in Science the perfect man, who appeared to him where sinning mortal man appears to mortals. In this perfect man the Saviour saw God's own likeness, and this correct view of man healed the sick. Thus Jesus taught that the kingdom of God is intact, universal, and that man is pure and holy.

210:11-16

Knowing that Soul and its attributes were forever manifested through man, the Master healed the sick, gave sight to the blind, hearing to the deaf, feet to the lame, thus bringing to light the scientific action of the divine Mind on human minds and bodies and giving a better understanding of Soul and salvation.

518:24-25, 27

Genesis i. 31. And God saw everything that He had made, and, behold, it was very good.

The divine Principle, or Spirit, comprehends and expresses all, and all must therefore be as perfect as the divine Principle is perfect. Nothing is new to Spirit.
